Academic year 2018-2019 has been a highly rewarding year for Loyola Alumni Association. The year has seen the starting of Chapters in different countries besides organising local chapters in India.

The year started with the organization of a Loyola Award programme to an illustrious Alumni of Loyola Shri Raja Arumugm a 1983 batch Graduate in Botany and currently the CHIEF MISSION SUPPORT OFFICER, UN special envoy to Syria on 29th June 2018. The programme was held at Bertram Hall.

Loyola Alumni Day was organized on 5th of Aug 2018 at Jubilee Quadrangle. 1700 Alumni participated in the event which had three different components. In the afternoon the Alumni visited their respective departments and wished their past and present professors besides discussing with them on the New Trends in Education and on how they are able to make use of the valuable education which they received at Loyola.

Shri L.Ramkumar Managing Director of Tube Investments of India limited, who studied PUC and B.Com at Loyola between 1972 and 1976 was awarded Loyola Alumni Award as 'Business man of the Year' and 5. Shri Inspiring Ilango, an inspiring and motivating public speaker was awarded with Loyola Alumni Award as the "Guiding light of the Year".

Presidential Medalists: Shri A.K.Viswanathan IPS, Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai was Honored for receiving the President's Medal for 'Meritorious Service' and Shri Xavier Britto, Chairman of Kerry- Indev was honored for receiving the prestigious Award for Logistics as 'World Customs Organisation Certificate of Merit'.
